COORDINATED BARGAINING-TWO SESSIONS COMPLETE!

On June 2, we wrapped up the second round of the four sessions scheduled for this year's coordinated bargaining between the local unions of the Alliance of Health Care Unions and Kaiser Permanente.

Using the current National Agreement as the basis of our negotiations, bargaining is organized into three workgroups to discuss:

- Economics (see more on back)
- Partnership enforcement and improvements
- Staffing, backfill, and budgeting

Each local is allocated a number of voting representatives based on their membership size.

OFNHP's representatives are President Adrienne Enghouse, Vice-President Katie Ekstrom, and Treasurer Elaine Carty.

We know that Kaiser has the money to fund our priorities - the company boasted a \$1.4 billion profit in the first quarter of 2018 alone!

But to secure the agreement that Kaiser caregivers and our patients deserve, we need to make sure KP knows that frontline union members are engaged and ready to do what it takes to win.

Let's keep up the pressure! Remember to RED UP every Tuesday. Management is paying attention.
