NEGOTIATIONS ENTER CRITICAL PHASE



Local bargaining update: Following months of unprecedented union activity, management's bargaining team finally made a counter-proposal to address our staffing concerns that included an initiation process for jointly creating staffing and backfill plans, and agreed to timelines for their completion. Management is still refusing to be accountable for the enforcement of those plans.

Three out of four of OFNHP's open contracts (RN, ONA, PRO) are nearing expiration.

From Oakland to KPB, management's bargaining agenda is clear:

- Gut our No-Cancellation policy
- Two-tiered Retirement (no pension for new hires)
- Increase copays for Rx and visits by 300%
- Limit our right to enforce violations of our staffing rights in the Nat'l Agreement
- Get OFNHP members to withdraw our class-action grievances on staffing
- Kaiser finance keeps veto power over our jointly-created staffing plans

With over \$2 billion in profits so far this year, it's time for KP to drop the takeaways and invest in patient care!
